Teachers must apply as a pair. Each teaching pair must include a Visual Arts teacher and a Social Studies or Language Arts or classroom teacher of grades 3 to 12.

*All teachers **must** commit to the full four-day Summer Institute for Teachers, the two class trips to the Morgan, the Technical Support Meeting, the classroom project, and the submission of three students’ works for consideration for the Morgan Book Project Award.
