 - AUGUST 15–18, 2017 (Grades 6–12)
- **Two class trips** to the Morgan Library and Museum with the participating students (October- November 2017)
- **A Technical Support Meeting** at the Morgan Library and Museum (December 2017)
- **A class project with Morgan program staff support** (October 2017-March 2018)
- **The Morgan Book Project Award** (TBD)

Teachers must apply as a pair. Each teaching pair must include a Visual Arts teacher and a Social Studies or Language Arts or classroom teacher of grades 3 to 12.

*All teachers **must** commit to the full four-day Summer Institute for Teachers, the two class trips to the Morgan, the Technical Support Meeting, the classroom project, and the submission of three students’ works for consideration for the Morgan Book Project Award.
