With over 200 drawings attributed to Giambattista Tiepolo and a rich holding of works by his Venetian contemporaries, the Morgan Library & Museum has the greatest collection of 18th century Venetian drawings in the United States. Participants will look closely at the drawings attributed to Tiepolo, Piazzetta, and their contemporaries in an attempt to understand their authenticity, materiality, and function, gaining insight into working methods and the centrality of drawing to the creative process.

This seminar is open to graduate students in the history of art. Interested participants are invited to submit a one paragraph statement, which should include the following:
