Yes, we want to apply to the MORGAN BOOK PROJECT, a free program for all New York City public schools, which includes:

- A **Four-Day Summer Institute for Teachers** at the Morgan Library and Museum (July/ August)
- **Two class trips** to the Morgan Library and Museum with the participating students (October- November)
- A **Technical Support Meeting** at the Morgan Library and Museum (December)
- A **class project with Morgan program staff support** (October- April)
- **The Morgan Book Project Award** (May)

Teachers must apply as a pair. Each teaching pair must include a Visual Arts teacher and a Social Studies or Language Arts or classroom teacher of grades Elementary to High School.

All teachers must commit to the full four-day Summer Institute for Teachers, the two class trips to the Morgan, the Technical Support Meeting, the classroom project, and the submission of three students' works for consideration for the Morgan Book Project Award.
