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## Story Cubes

Here's an idea for a creative family game night! Have an adult help you cut out the cube template above and fold along the dotted lines and tape each side until you have a cube.

Using pencils, crayons, or markers, draw a picture of a noun on each side (a noun is a person, place, or thing). Here are some of my favorites; a princess, a duck, a waterfall, a plane, a book... the possibilities are endless!

Once your cube has a picture on each side, it's story time! The first player rolls the cube and begins telling a story based on the picture that lands face up. The next player rolls, and continues the story based on their picture. Keep passing the cube and keep the story going! You decide when the story is over!
